Guidelines for Submitting Hall of Fame Nomination

Nominations must be submitted by 12:00 midnight, September 1, in any year in order to be considered for consideration in the same year.

Send nominations to HallofFame@usdaa.com.

1. Remember to include the nomination form
 - a. Be sure to fill out all the contact information so we can contact you if we need anything clarified
 - b. Check the appropriate nomination category
 - i. If nominating the same person or group in more than one category, please complete a separate nomination form for each category
 - c. If nominating for the Years of Service award, remember to check the box for the number of years
2. Attach a short essay (500 words or less) on how this nominee meets the criteria for the category selected and include the following information:
 1. The Person or Group's name
 2. Their hometown and state
 3. Principal Profession
 4. Birth Year
 5. Number of dogs
 6. Daytime contact info
 7. Email address
 - Essays can be a separate attachment or part of the nomination form
 - Typed essays are preferred
 - If hand writing your essay, please print clearly
3. We encourage you to submit up to two photos with your submission.
Please Note - If you are submitting a photo, you must list and describe the photos on the nomination form and sign the copyright waiver and indemnity agreement. If you are not the copyright holder, you may obtain the copyright owner's signature and list their contact on the form.
4. There are no restrictions on the number of inductions into USDAA's Hall of Fame for any category listed.

Once all nominations are received, they will be reviewed and categorized by USDAA staff. If necessary, a USDAA staff member will contact you for additional details.

All nominations will be critically voted on and approved by the USDAA Advisory Board or separate Hall of Fame Board.

Inductees into the USDAA Hall of Fame in any given year will be announced at the Cynosport® World Games. Specific dates and times for the award ceremony will be announced approximately 30 days prior to the event.
