

Masters/Performance III Super Q Calculation (Effective December 28, 2016)

Effective December 28, 2016, jump heights will no longer be combined or compared within a division to award Super Qs.

Two (2) or more dogs competing in a jump height: The dog must have a qualifying score in the top 15% of jump height.

One (1) dog competing in a jump height: The dog's score must be within 15% of the average of the first place qualifying scores across all jump heights. NOTE: When calculating the minimum score for a Super Q for this dog this dog's score is included in the calculation.

For Example: (If the 24" dog had gotten 40 points it would have earned a Super Q.)
