JUDGES: Any person whom the club deems has sufficient knowledge to successfully carry out the judging assignment subject to USDAA® approval or a judge on the USDAA® Approved Judges List may be engaged for conduct of the match. Judges not on the Approved Judges List must submit a course design for each class for approval by the USDAA® office.

ADVERTISING, SPONSORSHIPS, PRIZES AND AWARDS: All forms of advertising and sponsorship must comply with USDAA policies. Only USDAA, the host group, and USDAA approved sponsors shall be permitted to have their logos displayed on the front cover of test schedules, catalogs and other event materials (e.g., judging schedule). All advertising and sponsorships shall be limited to sale of single catalog page advertising and/or products supplied as trophies and awards of combined value less than \$500 without advance written USDAA approval. Sales of signage space in or about the show grounds or other forms of sponsorship are prohibited without advance written USDAA approval. Approved posted signage shall be no more than equal prominence of USDAA® and host group signage. All signage or any type must comply with local ordinances. Providers of trophies and awards must be listed in the appropriate section of the test catalog and may be given a courtesy listing in the Agility Test Schedule (but not on either outside cover). All prizes and awards shall be in good taste and shall not include cash prizes in excess of \$50.00 for a given class unless approved in writing.

GENERAL AGREEMENT: This application represents a limited license agreement between the "Host Organization" (hereinafter referred to as HOST) making this application and the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. Through this license agreement, USDAA temporarily grants permission for HOST to the temporary use of service marks of USDAA, specifically USDAA®, Agility Dog®, Advanced Agility Dog®, Master Agility Dog®, Agility Dog Champion®, Grand Prix of Dog Agility®, Dog Agility Masters®, Dog Agility Steeplechase®, Veteran Agility Dog®, Gamblers MasterSM, Snooker MasterSM, Jumpers MasterSM, Relay MasterSM, , Advanced Veteran Agility DogSM, Master Veteran Agility DogSM, Veteran GamblerSM, Veteran SnookerSM, Veteran JumperSM, Veteran Performance DogSM, Performance Dog ISM, Performance Dog IISM, Performance Dog IIISM, Performance GamblerSM, Performance SnookerSM, Performance JumperSM, Accomplished Performance DogSM, Junior Handler - Beginners AgilitySM, Junior Handler - Elementary AgilitySM, , Junior Handler - Intermediate AgilitySM, Junior Handler - Senior AgilitySM, Agility Top TenSM and any other marks so declared for the sole purpose of promoting the test or event for which this application is made. The term of this license shall expire at the conclusion of the test, or at such earlier time as may be established in writing by USDAA. USDAA reserves the right to revoke this license agreement including rights of use temporarily granted herein at any time for any reason or without cause. The acceptance and exercise of rights granted herein are made with the express understanding that United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. assumes no liability for the conduct of the test or activities associated therewith, or for losses sustained for revocation of this license for any reason. It is expressly understood by parties hereto that the service marks for which temporary use is granted shall remain at all times the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. Through submission of this application, the HOST, its officers, agents, representatives, principals, members and/or employees accept the terms and provisions set forth in this temporary limited use license agreement.

In consideration of the extension of limited rights of use under this license agreement as expressly stated above, HOST shall remit to USDAA licensing fees in the amount of \$.75 per entry in each class, the balance of which shall be due and payable with the group's Organizing Committee Report. Such fees are to be charged to competitors as part of their event entry fees. In addition, where sponsorship for an event exceeds \$500 in cash and/or product value, or where admission is being charged to spectators in connection with this event or an event of which this test shall be a part, the licensing fee shall be increased to include 25% of gross admissions and sponsorships, less a prorata portion of specific spectator-related expenses incurred in order to obtain admissions, such amounts to be agreed in advance and in writing from USDAA.

A \$50.00 non-refundable filing fee shall be submitted with this application. All other fees shall be remitted with the Organizing Committee's Report along with required attachments within five days following conclusion of this match. Failure to submit required reports and attachments may at the discretion of USDAA result in the assessment of administrative fines and penalties or revocation of host group agreement.
